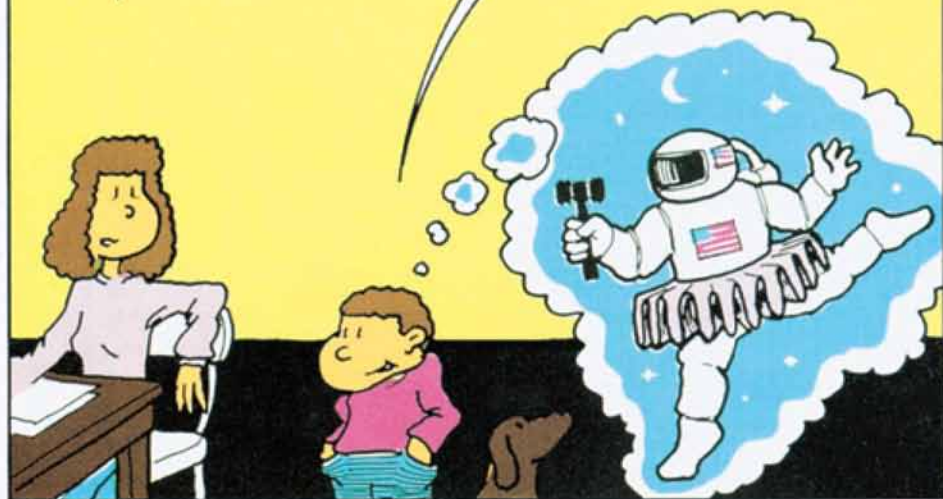

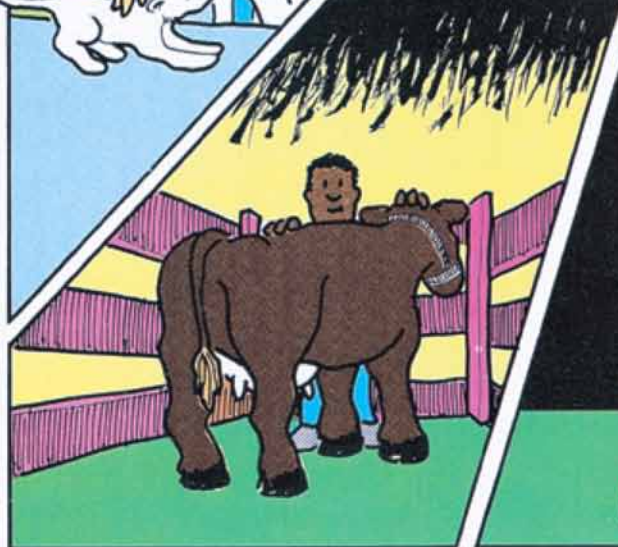


ABOUT 75% OF ALL OF THE VETERINARIANS IN THE UNITED STATES ARE IN PRIVATE PRACTICE...

**LATER, AT HOME...**

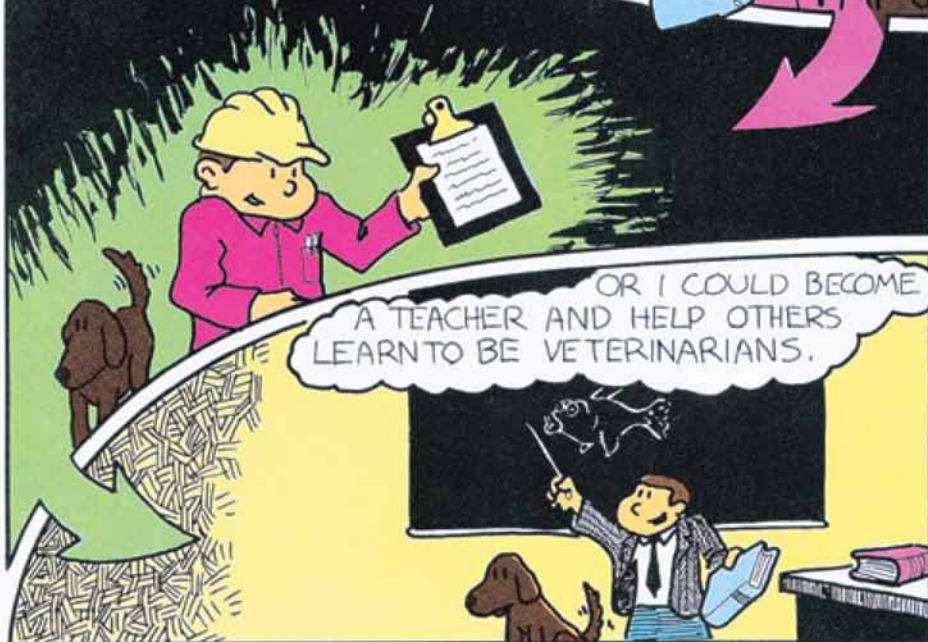

OR I COULD WORK TO PREVENT DISEASE IN LIVESTOCK AND HELP FARMERS...



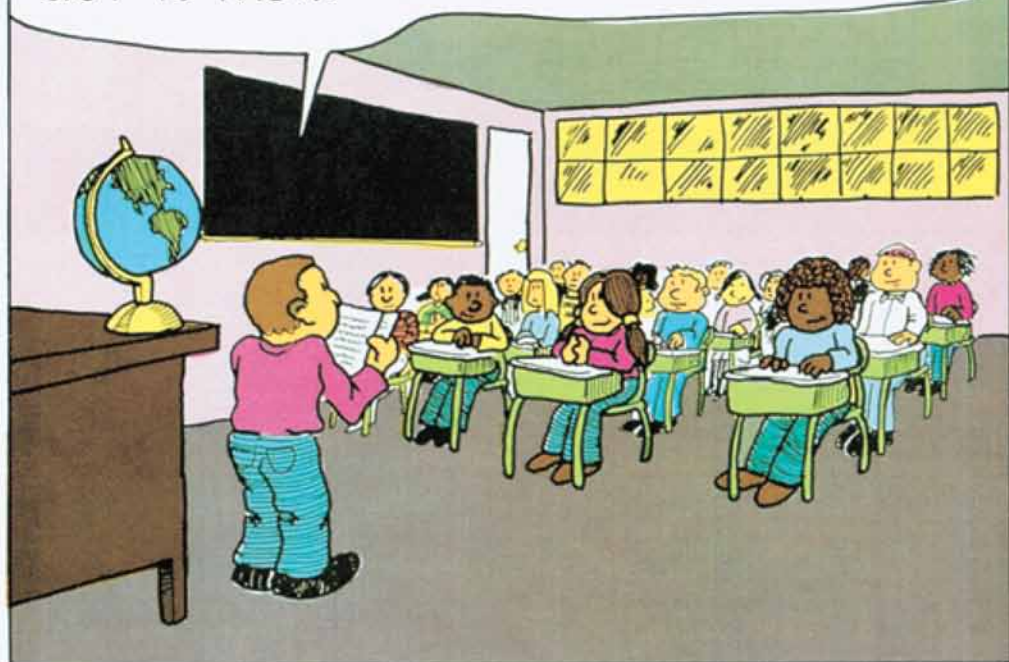
OR I COULD BECOME A TEACHER AND HELP OTHERS LEARN TO BE VETERINARIANS.

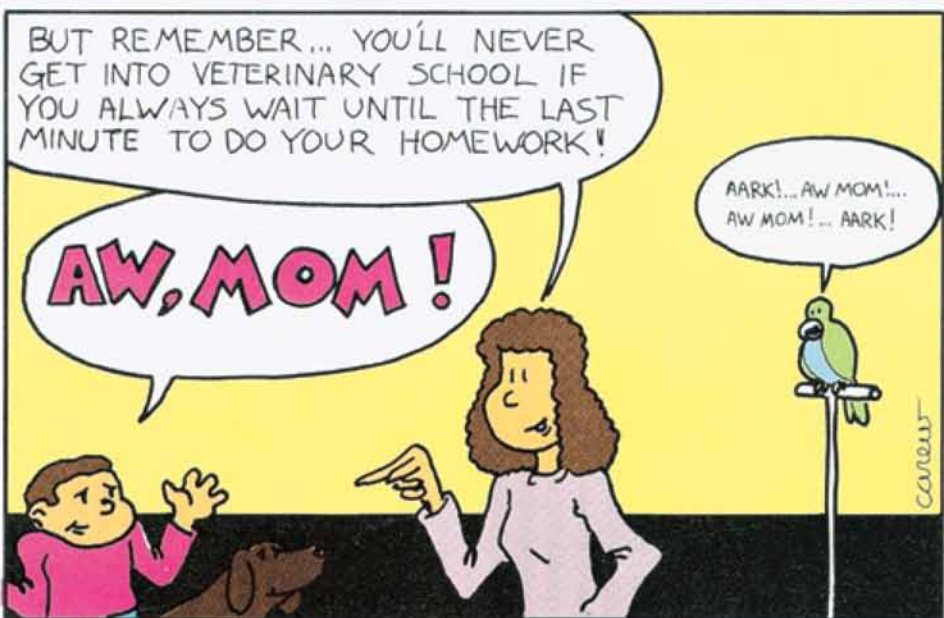




## **THE NEXT DAY...**
